



Former Water Sprayer Policy

The following rules apply to gins that have formerly used a water spray system and are now seeking to be Certified:

- A two year waiting period after the practice of spraying has stopped is required prior to receiving Primary Certification Status.
- Verification that water spraying has stopped is required.
- Exceptions may be granted as deemed acceptable by a 2/3 majority of the advisory board and full consent of the program sponsor, but in no case shall the waiting period be less than one full year. The applicant gin is responsible for petitioning the board and sponsor for the exemption.
- All other requirements of Primary Certification remain applicable.

This policy was developed with the counsel of the Advisory Board in 2006.
